PIPES

ATLAS was responsible for the handling of more than **700,000 tons of pipes**. Services provided included the preparation of the storage area, incoming inspection, transportation from vessel to storage area, offloading and stacking in storage area using ATLAS's owned specialized pipe handling reach stackers, loading from storage area on truck and transporting to quayside, and finally loading onto PSVs. **All this with ZERO accidents/incident or damage on pipes.**
